The Journey to Polymer Banknotes

We are pleased to announce the launch of “Transition: The Journey to Polymer Banknotes”, a virtual exhibition now accessible on the Central Bank’s website.

In December 2014, a special edition gold-coloured polymer \$50 note was commissioned to mark the 50th anniversary of the Central Bank of Trinidad and Tobago: this note was upgraded with tactile features in 2015. In December 2019, the Bank introduced the \$100 polymer note. The full polymer currency suite was introduced over time from November 2020 (\$5, \$10 and \$20) to February 2021 (\$1 and \$50) and since January 1, 2022, only the new polymer notes are legal tender.

This exciting, interactive virtual exhibition is rich in content, capturing the demonetization of the cotton notes with a focus on the polymer notes: the new designs, enhanced security features and the production process.
