HOW TO HANDLE YOUR POLYMER \$50 NOTES

EASY TO HANDLE

Your brand new polymer notes may sometimes stick together, but this lessens as they are used.

Separate your new polymer notes, tapping the stack on a hard surface to loosen, fanning them, or if it's just a few notes, snap them apart in between your fingers.

TO COUNT

If your polymer notes feel slippery to count, feel for the raised tactile areas which will act like a grip, hold a stack in one hand and, just like you would count cotton money, use your thumb of the hand holding the stack to push the top of the note to your free hand.

MORE TIPS:

- Clean dirty notes by wiping with a damp cloth.
- Dry wet notes by wiping with a dry cloth.
- Use clear, adhesive tape to repair cut notes.
- Polymer banknotes can be folded to fit into wallets and purses, but they prefer to be stored flat in a wallet, if possible, rather crumpling or folding tightly.
- If notes do become creased, they will flatten with pressure; rolling the notes will also flatten them.
