

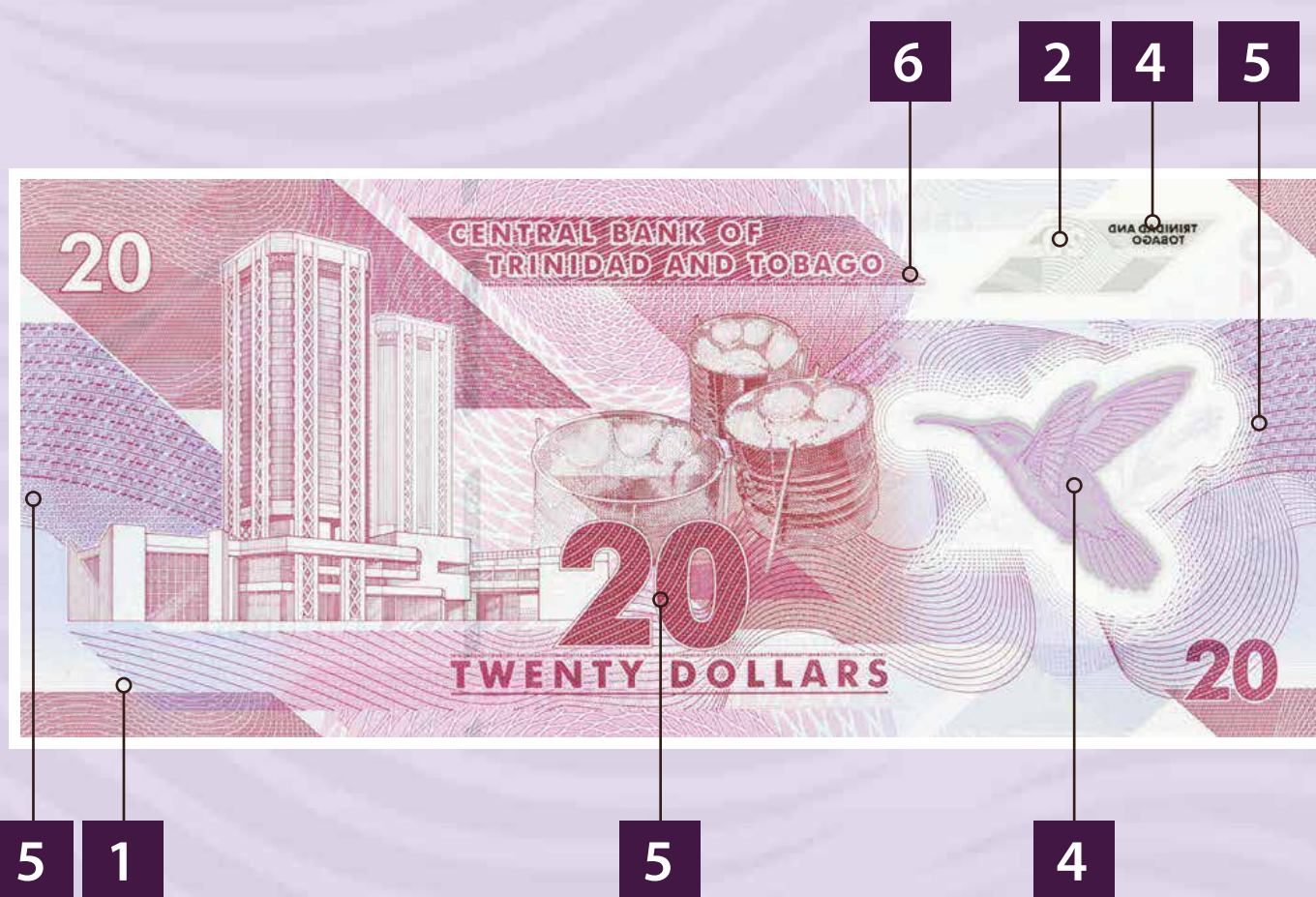

POLYMER BANKNOTE

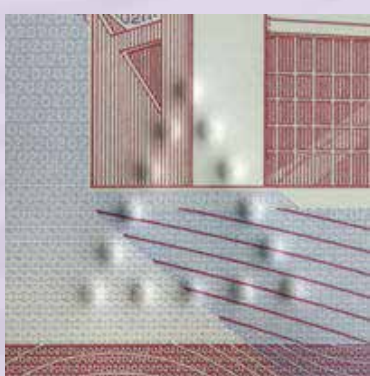
FRONT



REVERSE



FEEL



Polymer notes feel smoother than paper.

- 1 Run your fingers over the bottom corner of the note to feel the "triangle" shape.

LOOK



When you hold the note up to the light you will see:

- 2 A clear window that can be seen from the front and back of the note.
- 3 The numeral 20 appearing in the purple coloured print.

TILT



As you move the note around you will see:

- 4 Areas with a shimmering pink coloured ink.

CHECK



Using an ultra-violet (UV) light and a magnifier:

- 5 If you look at the note under UV light you will see that some areas of the note glow.
- 6 If you look at the note under magnification, some areas that appear as plain print are in fact very small letters and numbers.
