

## **KNOWING YOUR MONEY**

The Central Bank of Trinidad and Tobago has confirmed with our printers that there was a misprint on a few—less than 100 in number—of the \$20 notes in circulation. This misprint shows up as one side of the note being blank for the most part.

The Bank wishes to assure that the particular notes in question are valid legal tender and should be brought in to the Central Bank to be exchanged.

We also wish to remind the public of the need to be vigilant in recognising genuine banknotes.
