On March 21, 2019, the staff of the Central Bank joined the worldwide movement and rocked our socks in recognition of World Down Syndrome Day 2019.

World Down Syndrome Day (WDS) promotes the Lots of Socks campaign, which encourages people to wear colourful mismatched socks to make a statement that people with Down Syndrome (DS) are unique and special. The campaign advocates for the rights, inclusion and well-being of people with DS and has gained global recognition for raising public awareness. March 21 has been designated WDS as those with DS have an extra 21st chromosome, which causes the congenital disorder.
