

#### FEEL



### Polymer notes feel smoother than paper.



Run your fingers over the bottom corner of the note to feel the "circle" shape.

## When you hold the note up to the light you will see:

2 A clear window that can be seen from the front and back of the note.

3 The numeral 50 appearing in the brown coloured print.

#### IILI



### As you move the note around you will see:

4 Areas with a shimmering gold coloured ink.



#### Using an ultra-violet (UV) light and a magnifier:

- 5 If you look at the note under UV light you will see that some areas of the note glow.
- 6 If you look at the note under magnification, some areas that appear as plain print are in fact very small letters and numbers.
