Central Bank Museum's Virtual Exhibition: Life is a Celebration

The Central Bank Museum is pleased to launch the second installation of its *Life is a Celebration* virtual exhibition.

The exhibition features work by artists from across Trinidad and Tobago and will be accessible on the Central Bank **website** from Friday, May 28. Visitors to the virtual gallery will be able to view works from 49 of our talented artists.

We at the Museum know that nothing beats seeing works of art in person; however, given the current situation we are facing, we felt it important to keep our programming going and to continue to facilitate access and dialogue between the artist, the public and our institution.

The first installation in the Life is a Celebration virtual exhibition was launched last February 15, with works of art from the Bank's permanent collection. It featured the work of several local artists who used various media and styles to express the theme of celebration. Some of the events highlighted in that selection of work were Hosay, Carnival, Kartik and activities such as bele dancing, steelpan playing and limbo dancing.
