Central Bank Registers WAMNOW Technologies Limited to Issue Electronic Money in Trinidad and Tobago

PORT OF SPAIN, Trinidad. November 12, 2025 — On November 7, 2025, the Central Bank of Trinidad and Tobago registered WamNow Technologies Limited (WamNow) to carry on the business of an E-Money Issuer in Trinidad and Tobago using its digital wallet app, Wam (https://wam.money/). This follows the successful completion of its provisional registration period, which ended on November 6, 2025.

WamNow is a privately owned financial technology company, incorporated on February 26, 2021. The company aims to provide digital payment services to individuals and micro-enterprises through the use of its e-wallet, which can facilitate the storage of e-money and allow electronic transfers and payments within Trinidad and Tobago.

The company is registered to conduct the following activities:

- (a) issuance of e-money accounts;
- (b) cash-in:
- (c) cash-out:
- (d) provision of payment services; and
- (e) money transfer or remittances.

The Central Bank will continue to monitor WamNow's operations and regulatory compliance with legislation and guidelines governing e-money.
