## REDEMPTION OF THE \$100 COTTON NOTES AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2019

### **TOBAGO UPDATED FEBRUARY 4, 2020 BANKING HOURS FOR FEBRUARY AND MARCH 2020**

Consistent with the Guidelines for Redemption of the \$100 Cotton Notes after December 31, 2019 issued by the Central Bank of Trinidad and Tobago on January 17, 2020, the Central Bank will continue redemptions of the \$100 cotton notes for those persons who were hospitalized, incapacitated, out of the country or unable for legal or other demonstrably serious reasons to deposit or exchange the \$100 cotton notes by December 31, 2019.

The Central Bank has made arrangements for the collection of applications in Tobago for the months of February and March. Members of the public should walk with originals and photocopies of valid identification and any relevant documents to support their inability to convert the \$100 cotton notes by December 31, 2019.
